Warm Welcome




We would like to give a warm welcome to all our new and returning children and their families. The children are settling well into school life, building relationships, making friends and learning new routines.

Applications open on 1 October 2023 for primary school applications for entry in September 2024. The closing date is 15 January 2024



It is really important that you apply on time. If you apply late, you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools. Applications received after the 15 January 2024 will be classed as late applications and will not be processed until after the offer of places on 16 April 2024.
