

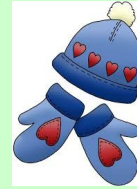


Bordesley Green East Nursery School Autumn Term 2 Newsletter 2023

Getting Ready for Colder Weather

Reception Class Application

Applications open on 1 October 2023 for primary school applications for entry in September 2024. **The closing date is 15 January 2024**



It is really important that you apply on time. If you apply late, you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools. **Applications received after the 15 January 2024 will be classed as late applications and will not be processed until after the offer of places on 16 April 2024.**
